member of a team at the same time, always work for the best result in a cooperative way with humility, modesty and discipline.

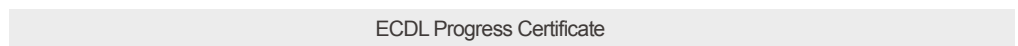
